- B. Here are some verses that you can always pray when you feel a battle coming on. In addition, pray that the Lord of the Breakthrough will give you your own personal words to defeat the enemy in your specific situation. He will do it!

Psalm 18:6 (NIV) In my distress I called to the Lord. I cried to my God for help.

2 Chronicles 20:15b (NIV) This is what the Lord says to you, "Do not be afraid or discouraged because of this vast army. For the battle is not yours but God's."

Isaiah 54:17 (NIV) No weapon formed against you will prevail and you will refute every tongue that accuses you. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord, and this is their vindication from me," declares the Lord.

Exodus 14:13-14 (NIV) Do not be afraid. Stand firm and you will see the deliverance the Lord will bring you today. The Egyptians you see today you will never see again. The Lord will fight for you; you need only to be still.

Psalm 56:9 (NIV) Then my enemies will turn back when I call for help. By this I will know that God is for me.

Psalm 91:1-2 (NIV) He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty. I will say of the Lord, "He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust."

2 Chronicles 20:22 (NIV) As they began to sing and praise, the Lord set ambushes against the men of Ammon and Moab and Mount Seir who were invading Judah, and they were defeated.

Ps. 18:14 (NIV) He shot his arrows and scattered the enemies, great bolts of lightning and routed them.

Ps. 142:7 (TM) Your people will form a circle around me and you'll bring me showers of blessing.

Ps. 144:5-6 (TM) Step down out of heaven, God; ignite volcanoes in the hearts of the mountains. Hurl your lightnings in every direction; shoot your arrows this way and that.

2 Cor. 10:4-5 (NIV) The weapons we fight with are not the weapons of the world. On the contrary, they have divine power to demolish strongholds. We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ.

Ephesians 6:10-12 (NIV) Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. Put on the full armor of God so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms.

Zephaniah 3:17 (NIV) The Lord your God is with you; he is mighty to save. He will take great delight in you, he will quiet you with his love, he will rejoice over you with singing.

Luke 10:17-19 (NIV) The seventy-two returned with joy and said, "Lord, even the demons submit to us in your name." He replied, "I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. I have given you authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy; nothing will harm you.

Phil. 2:10 (NIV) that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Romans 8:37(NIV) in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us.

Zechariah 4:6 (NIV) Not by might nor by power, but by my Spirit, says the Lord Almighty.
