<u>Jn 15:7-11 NAS</u>-- "If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. My Father is glorified by this, that you bear much fruit, and so prove to be My disciples. Just as the Father has loved Me, I have also loved you; abide in My love. If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love; just as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love. These things I have spoken to you so that My joy may be in you, and that your joy may be made full.

<u>Is 61:3 NAS</u>-- They will be called oaks of righteousness, the planting of the Lord, that He may be glorified.

<u>Jn 1:14 NLT</u>-- So the Word became human and lived here on earth among us. He was full of unfailing love and faithfulness. And we have seen his glory, the glory of the only Son of the Father.

<u>Jn 3:35</u> -- The Father loves the Son, and has given all things into His hand.

Rom 8:32-- He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?

<u>1 Jn 4:10 NIV</u>-- This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins.

Rom 3:24 NLT--God in his gracious kindness declares us not guilty. He has done this through Christ Jesus, who has freed us by taking away our sins.

<u>Eph 1:13 NLT</u>—When you believed in Christ, he identified you as his own by giving you the Holy Spirit

<u>Josh 23:14 NAS</u>—Not one word of all the good words which the LORD your God spoke concerning you has failed; all have been fulfilled for you, not one of them has failed.

Rom 6:6 NLT--Our old sinful selves were crucified with Christ so that sin might lose its power in our lives. We are no longer slaves to sin.

<u>Heb 4:16 AMP--</u> Let us then fearlessly and confidently and boldly draw near to the throne of grace (the throne of God's unmerited favor to us sinners), that we may receive mercy [for our failures] and find grace to help in good time for every need [appropriate help and well-timed help, coming just when we need it].

<u>1 Cor 10:13</u>-- God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear it.

Rom 8:28 MSG—We can be sure that every detail in our lives of love for God is worked into something good.

<u>Jn 11:25 NAS</u>--"I am the resurrection and the life; he who believes in Me will live even if he dies"

1 Cor 13:8—Love never fails

Rom 5:5--The love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us

Jm 4:2—You have not because you ask not

Rom 8:29-39 MSG-- God knew what he was doing from the very beginning. He decided from the outset to shape the lives of those who love him along the same lines as the life of his Son. The Son stands first in the line of humanity he restored. We see the original and intended shape of our lives there in him. 30 After God made that decision of what his children should be like, he followed it up by calling people by name. After he called them by name, he set them on a solid basis with himself. And then, after getting them established, he stayed with them to the end, gloriously completing what he had begun. 31 So, what do you think? With God on our side like this, how can we lose? 32 If God didn't hesitate to put everything on the line for us, embracing our condition and exposing himself to the worst by sending his own Son, is there anything else he wouldn't gladly and freely do for us? 33 And who would dare tangle with God by messing with one of God's chosen? 34 Who would dare even to point a finger? The One who died for us who was raised to life for us! - is in the presence of God at this very moment sticking up for us. 35 Do you think anyone is going to be able to drive a wedge between us and Christ's love for us? There is no way! Not trouble, not hard times, not hatred, not hunger, not homelessness, not bullying threats, not backstabbing, not even the worst sins listed in Scripture: 36 They kill us in cold blood because they hate you. We're sitting ducks; they pick us off one by one. 37 None of this fazes us because Jesus loves us. 38 I'm absolutely convinced that nothing - nothing living or dead, angelic or demonic, today or tomorrow, 39 high or low, thinkable or unthinkable - absolutely nothing can get between us and God's love because of the way that Jesus our Master has embraced us.
