- 1. <u>Ps 77:12 MSG</u>-- I'll ponder all the things you've accomplished, and give a long, loving look at your acts
- 2. <u>Ps 111:2 MSG</u>-- God's works are so great, worth a lifetime of study endless enjoyment!
- 3. <u>Ps 103:2 NLT</u>-- Praise the LORD, I tell myself, and never forget the good things he does for me.
- 4. <u>Ps 143:5 NLT</u>-- I remember the days of old. I ponder all your great works. I think about what you have done.
- 5. <u>Ps 98:3 NLT</u>-- He kept his promise to the people of Israel with loyalty and constant love for them. All people everywhere have seen the victory of our God.
- 6. <u>Deut 4:9 MSG</u>-- Don't forget anything of what you've seen. Don't let your heart wander off. Stay vigilant as long as you live.
- 7. <u>Deut 24:18 AMP</u>-- You shall [earnestly] remember that you were a slave in Egypt and the Lord your God redeemed you from there
- 8. <u>Josh 23:14 NLT</u>-- Every promise of the LORD your God has come true. Not a single one has failed!
- 9. <u>Neh 4:14 AMP</u>-- Do not be afraid of the enemy; [earnestly] remember the Lord and imprint Him [on your minds], great and terrible, and [take from Him courage to] fight
- 10. <u>Neh 9:17 NAS</u>-- They refused to listen, and did not remember Your wondrous deeds which You had performed among them; so they became stubborn and appointed a leader to return to their slavery in Egypt. But You are a God of forgiveness, gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and abounding in lovingkindness; and You did not forsake them
- 11. <u>Rev 3:3 AMP</u>-- Call to mind the lessons you received and heard; continually lay them to heart and obey them
- 12. <u>Ps 111:4 MSG</u>-- His miracles are his memorial This God of Grace, this God of Love.
- 13. <u>Ps 63:5-6 AMP</u>-- My whole being shall be satisfied as with marrow and fatness; and my mouth shall praise You with joyful lips when I remember You upon my bed and meditate on You in the night watches
- 14. <u>Ps 77:14 NLT</u>-- You are the God of miracles and wonders!
- 15. <u>Ps 78:35 AMP</u>-- They [earnestly] remembered that God was their Rock, and the Most High God their Redeemer
- Ps 106:7 AMP-- Our fathers in Egypt understood not nor appreciated Your miracles; they did not [earnestly] remember the multitude of Your mercies nor imprint Your loving-kindness [on their hearts], but they were rebellious and provoked the Lord
- 17. <u>Ps 111:4 AMP</u>-- He has made His wonderful works to be remembered; the Lord is gracious, merciful, and full of loving compassion.
- 18. <u>Ps 143:5 AMP</u>-- I remember the days of old; I meditate on all Your doings; I ponder the work of Your hands
- 19. <u>Is 12:4 NAS</u>-- Give thanks to the LORD, call on His name. Make known His deeds among the peoples
- 20. <u>Is 46:9 AMP</u>—[Earnestly] remember the former things, [which I did] of old; for I am God, and there is no one else; I am God, and there is none like Me,
- 21. <u>Lam 3:21-23</u>-- But this I call to mind, and therefore I have hope: the steadfast love of the Lord never ceases, his mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness.
- 22. <u>1 Chronicles 16:12 AMP</u>-- [Earnestly] remember the marvelous deeds which He has done, His miracles, and the judgments He uttered

- 23. <u>Ps 77:10 AMP</u>-- I will recall the years of the right hand of the Most High in loving-kindness extended toward us
- 24. <u>Ps 77:11 AMP</u>-- I will [earnestly] recall the deeds of the Lord; yes, I will [earnestly] remember the wonders [You performed for our fathers] of old.
- 25. <u>Is 63:7 NLT</u>-- I will tell of the LORD's unfailing love. I will praise the LORD for all he has done. I will rejoice in his great goodness to Israel, which he has granted according to his mercy and love
- 26. <u>Ps 105:5 AMP</u>-- Earnestly remember the marvelous deeds that He has done, His miracles and wonders, the judgments and sentences which He pronounced upon His enemies
- 27. <u>Lam 3:20-22 MSG</u>-- I remember it all oh, how well I remember the feeling of hitting the bottom. But there's one other thing I remember, and remembering, I keep a grip on hope: God's loyal love couldn't have run out, his merciful love couldn't have dried up.
- 28. <u>Deut 4:9 NLT</u>-- But watch out! Be very careful never to forget what you have seen the LORD do for you. Do not let these things escape from your mind as long as you live! And be sure to pass them on to your children and grandchildren.
- 29. <u>Is 46:9 NLT</u>-- Do not forget the things I have done throughout history. For I am God I alone! I am God, and there is no one else like me
- 30. <u>1 Cor 10:1 NLT</u>-- I don't want you to forget, dear brothers and sisters, what happened to our ancestors in the wilderness long ago. God guided all of them by sending a cloud that moved along ahead of them, and he brought them all safely through the waters of the sea on dry ground.
- 31. <u>Heb 13:8 NLT</u>-- Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.
- 32. Ps 103:2 MSG-- O my soul, bless God, don't forget a single blessing!
- 33. Ps 63:2 NIV-- I have seen you in the sanctuary and beheld your power and your glory
- 34. <u>Ps 77:11 MSG</u>-- Once again I'll go over what God has done, lay out on the table the ancient wonders
- 35. Ps 103:2 KJV-- Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits
- 36. <u>Ps 143:5 MSG</u>-- I remembered the old days, went over all you've done, pondered the ways you've worked
- 37. <u>Ps 77:14 MSG</u>-- You're the God who makes things happen; you showed everyone what you can do
- 38. <u>1 Cor 12:6 NKJV</u>-- There are diversities of activities, but it is the same God who works all in all.
- 39. <u>Phil 4:19 NLT</u>-- And this same God who takes care of me will supply all your needs from his glorious riches, which have been given to us in Christ Jesus.
- 40. <u>Ps 78:2-4 MSG</u>-- I'm chewing on the morsel of a proverb; I'll let you in on the sweet old truths, stories we heard from our fathers, counsel we learned at our mother's knee. We're not keeping this to ourselves, we're passing it along to the next generation God's fame and fortune, the marvelous things he has done.
- 41. <u>Josh 23:14 MSG</u>-- Know this with all your heart, with everything in you, that not one detail has failed of all the good things God, your God, promised you. It has all happened. Nothing's left undone not so much as a word.
- 42. Josh 4:1-7 NLT-- When all the people were safely across the river, the LORD said to Joshua, 2 "Now choose twelve men, one from each tribe. 3 Tell the men to take twelve stones from where the priests are standing in the middle of the Jordan and pile them up at the place where you camp tonight." 4 So Joshua called together the twelve men 5 and told them, "Go into the middle of the Jordan, in front of the Ark of the LORD your God. Each of you must pick up one stone and carry it out on your shoulder twelve stones in all, one for each of the twelve tribes. 6 We will use these stones to build a memorial. In the future, your children will ask, 'What do these stones mean to you?' 7 Then you can tell them, 'They remind us that the Jordan River stopped flowing when the Ark of the LORD's covenant went across.' These stones will stand as a permanent memorial among the people of Israel."
